- Possible new funding and financing options

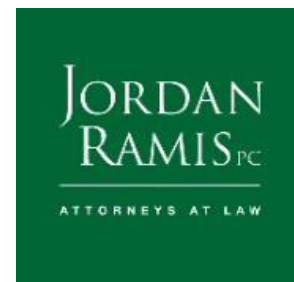
